EMERCOM psychologists help their Belarusian colleagues



“More than 50 people applied to Russian psychologists for help after the terrorist attack in the Minsk metro” - said the director of the Center of emergency psychological aid of EMERCOM of Russia Yulia Shoigu, who is heading a group of psychologists working in Minsk.

“Together with our Belarusian colleagues on requests we are working in three hospitals where the victims of attack are under the treatment. Our psychologists are working on “hot line” telephones and with specialists, having eliminated the consequences of terrorist attack, we also participate in all the activities”- she noted.

Experience of Russian psychologists in providing emergency psychological aid to victims in emergency situations caused interests greatly the Belarusian colleagues.

“First of all, they are interested in the organization of work, skills for emergency psychological aid in emergency situations, including psychological support of personnel” - said Yulia Shoigu. She also said that psychologists of EMERCOM of Russia will work in Minsk, as long as the situation requires.
