EMERCOM psychologists are helping the injured and relatives of those killed in the terrorist attack in Minsk

Yesterday at 17.55 (MSK.) a group of 10 psychologists of EMERCOM of Russia arrived in Minsk to provide emergency psychological aid to the injured and relatives of those killed in the terrorist attack in Minsk.

EMERCOM specialists for emergency psychological aid set to work immediately after arrival.

Currently, the psychologists are working in 3 hospitals in Minsk, where the injured were brought to, they also help people who have applied for telephone “hot line”.

As at 9.00 (MSK.) 13.04.2011 psychological aid was provided in 34 cases of appeals.

Russian psychologists are ready to provide guidance and share experience with their Belarusian colleagues in providing assistance to victim in emergency situations.
