**Press-conference of the Head of the Department of Supervisory Activities
EMERCOM of Russia Yuriy Deshevykh took place in the “Moscow

Topics of the press-conference:

1 May 2010 is the deadline to file the fire safety declaration The results of the first year since the implementation of the Federal Law “Technical enactment about fire safety requirements”. The necessity of fire insurance implementation in the field of fire safety. 30 April is the Firefighting Service Day 1 May is the deadline to file a fire safety declaration

According to the Federal law of the Russian Federation dated 22 July 2008 №123-Φ3 “Technical enactment about fire safety requirements”, the owners of the facilities which are operating today, must file the **Fire Safety Declaration till 1 May 2010**. The owners of the facilities which are only being built have to file the declaration before the commissioning. The documents must contain the information about fire safety measures, which the owner of the facility must follow. It is worthy of note that the declaration is filed in the notification requirement: the owner of the facility informs the supervisory bodies EMERCOM of Russia that he/she follows fire safety requirements. According to the information received from the Department of Supervisory Activities on 23 April 2010, 92.5% of declarations have been filed already.

Special working schedule is made in the divisions of the State Fire Safety Authority till the end of the period of declarations filing (1 May 2010): till 20:00 during the week, till 14:00 at the week-end.

The first year since the implementation of the Federal Law of the 22 July 2008 №123-Φ3 “Technical enactment about fire safety requirements” is coming to an end (the Law came into power on 1 May 2009)

One of the main novations, implemented by the technical enactment is the requirement to fire stations depending on the arrival time of the first firefighting groups at the emergency site.

According to the article 76 “**Fire Safety Requirements on the placement of firefighting stations in settlements and urban districts**”, part 17 “**General Fire Safety Requirements to the settlements and urban districts on placement of firefighting stations**” Φ3 “Technical enactment about fire safety requirements” the “dislocation of the firefighting units on the territories of settlements and urban districts is defined according to the requirement for the arrival of the first unit in no more than 10 minutes in urban districts and 20 minutes in settlements”.

Since the implementation of the Federal Law “Technical enactment about fire safety requirements” more than 300 firefighting stations have been built in order to realize this norm. Therefore, the number of the settlements, protected
