The "Centrospas" Unit has been in the rescue service for 29 years



On March 13, 1992, in accordance with the decree of the Government of the Russian Federation, the State Central Airmobile Rescue Team of the Russian Emergencies Ministry "Centros pas" was created. Today the Unit is 29 years old from the date of its formation. The Unit's specialists are capable of performing the most complex emergency rescue operations anywhere in the world.

On the eve of the memorable date, the employees of the organization honored the memory of their heroically perished colleagues and took part in the rewarding of the active staff for service. Employees of the organization laid flowers at the Bykovskoye cemetery at the monuments - to Dmitry Kormilin and Valery Zamaraev, heroes who died in the line of duty in North Ossetia.

Today there are more than 500 employees in the Unit. These are high-level specialists, including 32 international class rescuers, 25 honored rescuers of the Russian Federation. In addition, 9 members of the detachment have the title of "Honored Worker of the Russian Federation".

Each member of the unit has several related specialties: gas welder, slinger, diver, work at height using rope access systems, dog handler, driver, speleologist and many others.

Since the formation of the detachment, more than 62 thousand rescue operations have been carried out, 217 of which are foreign. More than 11.2 thousand people were rescued, assistance was rendered to 44.5 thousand victims.

In 2020 alone, the detachment's personnel were involved in emergency rescue operations more than 2.2 thousand times, most often associated with the elimination of the consequences of road accidents, fires in the residential sector, accidents at water bodies, and over a thousand people were rescued.

So, last year, the personnel of the Centros pas Unit was involved in eliminating the consequences of the explosion in the city of Beirut of the Lebanese Republic, where 113 people and 6 pieces of equipment were involved. In addition to carrying out emergency rescue operations at the site of the emergency, the work of the airmobile hospital of the Centros pas Unit was organized, whose specialists provided assistance to more than 600 injured people.

In addition, last year with. Belokamenka, Kola District, Murmansk Region, an airmobile hospital of the Centros pas Unit (37 people and 5 units of equipment) was deployed to carry out measures to organize the protection of the population and territory from the spread of coronavirus infection.
