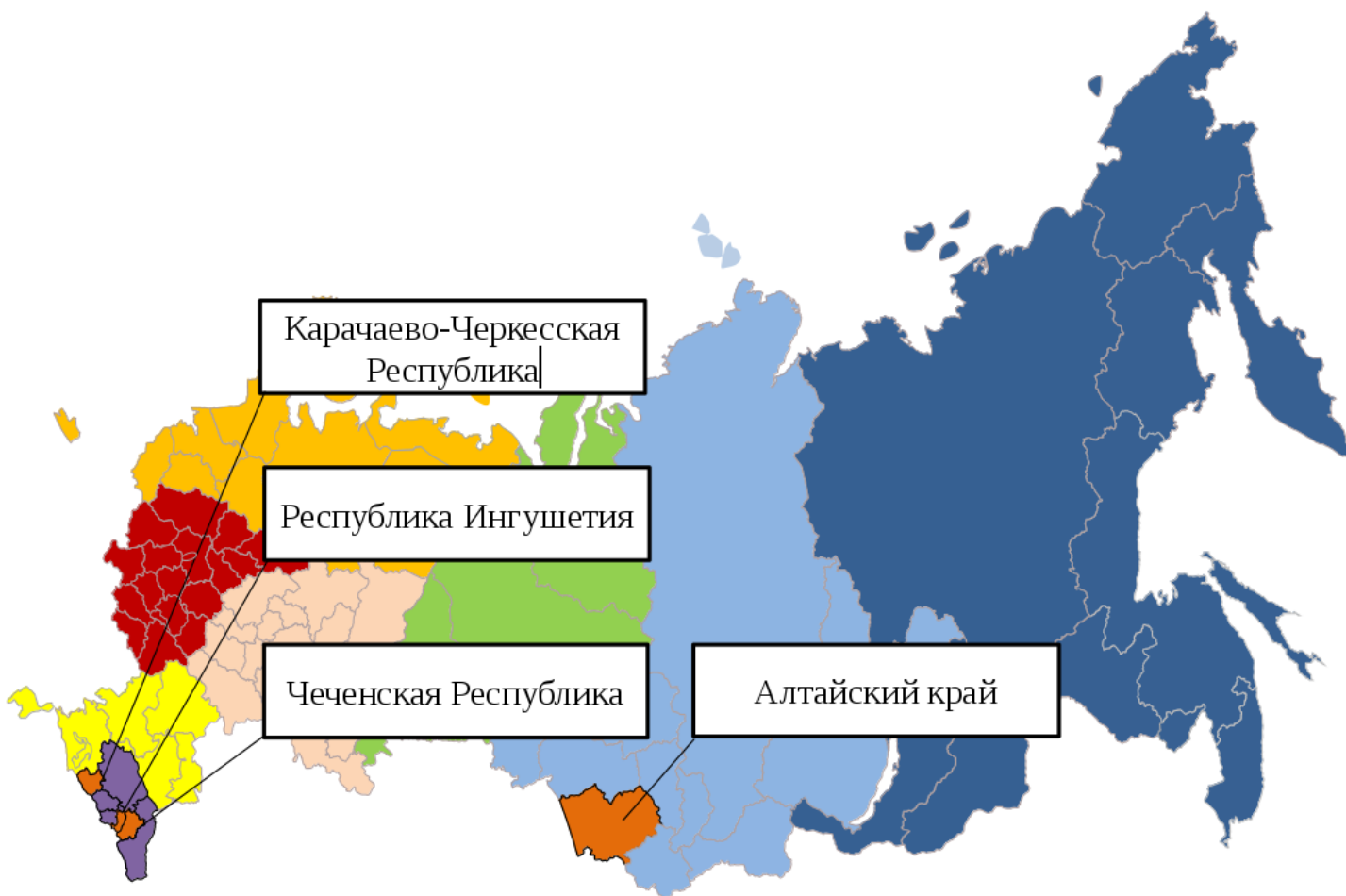

Daily operational forecast for March 24, 2021



The operational forecast of possible emergency situations for March 24, 2021 on the territory of the Russian Federation is determined by the passage of 3 cyclones, 3 anticyclones and the atmospheric fronts.

Due to the severe weather phenomena, the emergencies including the disruption of life support services, energy facilities, communications, housing and communal services, and all modes of transport, flooding of low-lying areas are forecast:

in the Siberian Federal District, in the Altai Territory (precipitation in the form of snow, sleet and rain, blizzards, black ice on the roads, wind up to 23 m/s, wind gusts up to 32 m/s in some areas);

in the North Caucasian Federal District, in the Republic of Ingushetia, the Chechen Republic (in mountainous regions, strong winds up to 32 m/s); Karachay-Cherkess Republic (heavy precipitation - rain, snow, sleet).

Due to the adverse weather phenomena, the accidents including the disruption of life support systems, all modes of transport, power lines breakage are forecast:

in the Siberian Federal District, in the Republic of Tyva, in the south of the Taimyr municipal district, the Krasnoyarsk Territory (blizzard, black ice, wind gusts up to 22 m/s), in the Altai Republic (wind speed up to 25 m/s in some areas, up to 35 m/s in high mountains), the Kemerovo Region (precipitation in the form of rain and sleet, blizzards in some areas, black ice on the roads, wind up to 24 m/s);

in the Southern Federal District, in the Republic of Crimea (heavy precipitation, ice and hoarfrost on wires and trees, strong wind); the Republic of Adygea (Maykop district), Volgograd Region, Krasnodar Region, Rostov Region (heavy precipitation, adhesion of wet snow on wires and trees); in the Krasnodar Territory (Novorossiysk municipal district), the Volgograd Region (wind up to 20 m/s);

in the North Caucasian Federal District, in the Kabardino-Balkarian Republic, the Republic of North Ossetia-Alania (gusty wind up to 28 m/s); in the Stavropol Territory (heavy precipitation - rain, snow, sleet).

The landslides, landslips, subsidence of soil in the mountainous and foothill areas are forecast in the North Caucasian Federal and Southern Federal districts.

There is an avalanche danger in the mountainous regions of the Far Eastern Federal District (Kamchatka Territory, Sakhalin Region, Magadan Region), Siberian Federal District (Krasnoyarsk Territory, Republic of Altai, Republic of Khakassia, Tyva, Irkutsk and Kemerovo regions), the Southern Federal District (Republic of Adygea, Krasnodar
