**The leadership of the EMERCOM of Russia takes part in the St. Petersburg  
International Economic Forum**



The St. Petersburg International Economic Forum continues its work in St. Petersburg. The traditional participants of the forum are representatives of the Russian Emergencies Ministry. The delegation of the Ministry is headed by the head of the Russian Emergencies Ministry Evgeniy Zinichev. Representatives of the Ministry participate in sessions and discussions taking place these days at the ExpoForum site.

Thus, State Secretary - Deputy Head of Department Alexey Serko took part in the Forum section "Trust in National Jurisdiction as a Factor of Economic Development and Business Protection", where he made a report "On the Implementation of the "Regulatory Guillotine "Mechanism in Order to Promote the Protection of the Economy and Business".

"Today in Russia, a large-scale reform of control and supervisory activities is in full swing, called the "regulatory guillotine ". EMERCOM of Russia is the most direct participant in the implementation of its mechanisms," Alexey Serko said.

In connection with the adoption in July 2020 of two basic federal laws: "On Mandatory Requirements" (No. 247-FZ) and "On State Control and Supervision" (No. 248-FZ), security ". In particular, it was proposed to systematize the mandatory fire safety requirements, to expand the conditions under which the objects of protection will be able to comply with them, to exclude outdated and excessive requirements for fire extinguishing equipment and personal protection. Thus, the Russian technical regulations for fire safety have been brought in line with the technical regulations of the Eurasian Economic Union.

Also, as part of the implementation of the mechanisms of the "regulatory guillotine" of the Ministry of Emergency Situations of Russia, amendments were prepared to the federal laws "On Fire Safety" and "On Licensing of Certain Types of Activities" aimed at improving the procedure for licensing activities in the field of fire safety and establishing regulations for confirming the conformity issued for these purposes products.

"For the heads of enterprises, a notification procedure is introduced to notify about the work carried out and the services provided instead of the previously valid one. At the same time, a deadline has been set once every 3 years to confirm compliance with licensing requirements. The licensing authority will have the right to cancel the license through the court or suspend its validity - in the event of repeated or gross violation of license requirements. On June 2, the law was approved by the Federation Council, " Aleksey Serko said.

He also added that in order to make the fire supervision procedure more "transparent", the Ministry initiated a number of proposals that were included in the Sputnik law,
